

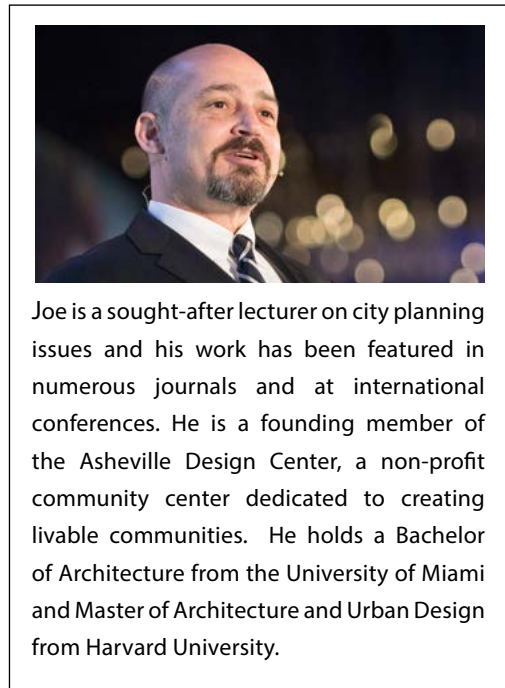

Joe Minicozzi, AICP is the principal of Urban3, a consulting firm created by Asheville real estate developer, Public Interest Projects. Urban3’s work in pioneering geo-spatial representation of economic productivity has prompted a paradigm shift in understanding the economic potency of urbanism and the value of well designed cities.



Joe is a sought-after lecturer on city planning issues and his work has been featured in numerous journals and at international conferences. He is a founding member of the Asheville Design Center, a non-profit community center dedicated to creating livable communities. He holds a Bachelor of Architecture from the University of Miami and Master of Architecture and Urban Design from Harvard University.
