



## Notes on Sources:

1. ACS 2020(5) refers to the five-year 2020 American Community Survey. It is a sample-based product that surveys about 1 in 9 U.S. households annually over the course of ten years. Since it is sample-based, the ACS is more accurate for larger geographies. Figures for areas with less than 5,000 population, and especially those under 1,500 population, are subject to large margins of error and should be used with caution.
2. The CTPP is the Census Transportation Planning Package, a special survey based on ACS sample data for years 2012–2016. Note that the figures for jobs by place of work tend to run low.
3. All statistics on owner-occupied units refer to units with a mortgage.
