RESOLUTION 23-07

ADOPTING CENTRAL ARKANSAS REGIONAL GREENWAYS PLAN TO GUIDE MULTIUSE PATHS INVESTMENT IN THE CENTRAL ARKANSAS REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION STUDY AREA

WHEREAS, Metroplan is the officially designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Little Rock-North Little Rock-Conway metropolitan area; and

WHEREAS, the MPO is charged with the responsibility of guiding federal transportation investments for multiple modes in the Central Arkansas Regional Transportation Study area; and

WHEREAS, *Resolution 20-05* adopted a strategic target of fifty-five million dollars, over 10 fiscal years for the purpose of planning, development, and construction of a regional multi-use path network on February 26, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Central Arkansas Regional Greenways Plan defines a network of regional routes for connecting cities via an active transportation network and fulfills the requirement for the development of regional master plan; and


WHEREAS, the public was given opportunities to participate in the plans development; and
