## Size of HSV



- 26,192 acres
- 15 miles from West Gate to East Gate on Desoto Blvd
- 34,227 Platted Lots
  - 26.4% Developed



## Demographics

- 2020 Population of 15,861
  - Garland County: 8000
  - Saline County: 7861
- 800 children
  - 700 students in Jessieville/Fountain Lake
- 9200 Rooftops
  - 100 new builds/year...\$300,000 plus average sale





## Governance

- Incorporated as a Private Corporation
  - Functions as a Private Community (City)
- Seven Member Board of Directors
  - Rotation Annual Elections (2 or 3 positions)
- Full-Time General Manager
  - Supported by 400+ POA Employees
- Volunteer Committees to Support POA Staff
  - Public Services
  - Golf
  - Government Affairs
  - Architectural Control
  - Lakes
  - Recreation







## POA-Owned Infrastructure

- Private Roads...500 miles
  - 472 paved
- Water Treatment Plant
  - 6 MGD Production Capacity
  - Lake Lago Reservoir (years supply of water)
- Two Waste Water Treatment Plants
- Woodlands Auditorium...654 Seating Capacity
- Community Center/Library Complex







## POA-provided Services


- Police (23 personnel)
  - Deputized in both Garland & Saline Counties
  - 911 Dispatch
- Fire (22 personnel)
  - Four-manned Stations
- Ambulance
  - Three manned Paramedic Vehicles
- Code Compliance
- Recreation Dept
  - Trails/Parks/Beaches
- Animal Control





## Amenities

- 12 Lakes (3800+ Registered Boats)
- 9 ½ Golf Courses
  - 8 ½ Member...One Private County Club
  - 230,000 rounds per year
- 13 Tennis Courts
- Pickleball Complex..14 courts
- 30 miles of Hiking Trails
- 23 miles of Bike Routes
- RV park







## Average Villager

- 69 Years Old
- 74% born outside of Arkansas
  - Iowa/Wisconsin/Minnesota
- Median Income of \$59,000
- 76% receiving Social Security Benefits
- Influx of Californians & Texans





## **Economic Impact**

- \$397M Annual Impact on Arkansas
- School Districts
  - Jessieville: 76% of Millage
  - Fountain Lake: 78% of millage
- Counties:
  - Garland: 9.4% Millage (8% Pop)
  - Saline: 11.5% Millage (6% Pop)
- Not Eligible for most Federal/State/County Tax Dollars

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# ACT 605 & CRYPTOMINING UPDATES

- Proposed Cryptomining Legislation
  - \* Amended versions of 2 crypto mining bills have cleared AR Senate committee
  - Clarifies noise-reduction practices
  - Prohibits foreign ownership
  - \* Allows local governments to impose different requirements than on data centers generally, and to rezone to prohibit cryptomining activities

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# UDO & BEST ZONING PRACTICES

Proactive	Reactive
Robust public involvement upfront, during development of regulations	Public hearings dominated by loudest/most resources (money, time, education)
Administrative approvals	Complex application process
Objective standards	Subjective discretion
Technical expertise	Personal interests
Predictability	Uncertainty
Consistent outcomes	Unpredictable outcomes
