GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

- Arkansas Community Assistance Grant Program (CAGP)
 - Supports community & economic development projects
 - Max funding up to \$1.5 million per project
 - 20% match in cash/in kind : labor/ material/ land
 - Award Criteria: Determined by AEDC based on eligibility, available funds & program demand
 - Eligible Applicants:
 - Cities & Incorporated towns
 - Counties & Unincorporated communities
 - Non-Profits & Other Govt. entities in Arkansas
 - Eligible Projects:
 - Renovation/Construction of public facilities
 - Healthcare centers, libraries, city halls, police stations, jails, parks, playgrounds, etc.
 - Land or building purchase for related projects
 - Workforce training expense

GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

- FUN Park Grants | Arkansas Department of Parks, Heritage, & Tourism
 - Deadline: 29 August 2025
 - Max funding up to \$100,000/ project | No match required
 - Award Criteria: Determined by Outdoor Recreation Grants Advisory Committee.
 - Eligible Applicants:
 - Municipalities with population below 7,500
 - Unincorporated communities sponsored by cities or counties
 - Applicant should not have won a FUN grant within last
 5 years
 - Eligible Projects:
 - Development of most outdoor recreation facilities.
 - Grant projects should be completed within One Year of contract date.
