

#### 1992 Review and Outlook

The Little Rock-North Little Rock Metropolitan Area (MSA) is comprised of Pulaski, Saline, Faulkner and Lonoke counties. In January, 1992 the population of the MSA was estimated to be 538,198 persons, a change of 14,741 since 1990. This represents an annual increase of 1.41 percent compared to an annual growth rate of 1.03 percent during the 1980-1990 decade.

The City of Conway in Faulkner County is experiencing significant growth in its housing market. A total of 368 single family housing units were permitted, up from the 1990 record of 271 permits. There were 657 building permits issued in Conway for all types of construction which total \$45,826,102 representing the highest yearly total for which records were available.

Local socio-economic indicators were mixed in 1991. Healthy gains were experienced in bank deposits and assets in Pulaski and Saline counties. Assessed valuation of real estate and personal property rose 2.6 and 2.7 percent, respectively. The unemployment rate was up to 6.2 percent as compared to the 1990 figure of 5.9 percent.

#### Outlook

Construction activity will continue at a high level of production in the city of Conway in Faulkner County.

The Arkansas Home Builders Association reported that Faulkner County was the third most active county in the state for home construction just behind Washington and Benton counties in northwest Arkansas.

Continued gain are expected in assessed valuations, bank deposits and bank assets.



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
